Psychological Science (Hons)

Throughout this honours year students will build upon their understanding of the frameworks of psychology theory and practice, focusing on research methods and professional skills.

Graduates are prepared for work in a number of settings including research, psychiatric hospitals, special schools, government, not-for-profit organisations, human resource management, market research and guidance or counselling for educational, vocational or personal problems.

Completion of an accredited honours degree in psychology opens up a wealth of potential for your future career in psychology. Graduates can complete a two-year Master program or one-year professional Master postgraduate program, both offered by ISN Psychology and available for current, past, and future students to apply for. This course is accredited by the Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC).

Entry Requirements

- Entry to the 4th year Honours programme in Psychology at ISN requires successful
 completion of an APAC accredited three year sequence in psychology eg. a Bachelor
 Degree in psychology, or a Bachelor Degree in any discipline plus an APAC-accredited
 sequence in psychology or qualification obtained from an overseas education institution
 assessed as comparable to an APAC-accredited qualification/three year sequence in
 psychology.
- Additionally, candidates must meet minimum English language proficiency standards for entry to an AQF level 8 Honours degree.
- Domestic students with Australian citizenship or Permanent Residency rights can apply, ISN cannot currently accept applications for international students.
- The entry quota for this course may differ each year depending on the applications received.

Career Pathways

This honours year is an accredited fourth year in the sequence to becoming a provisional, and then practising psychologist. Completing this course will set graduates up for success in the higher degree and 5+1 pathways to becoming a registered psychologist in Australia.

Successful completion of this honours program allows for associate membership with the Australian Psychological Society (APS).

Tuition and

Course Structure

This honours year consists of one year full time study, or the part-time equivalent. The structure is based on two full-time semesters, each with a duration of 12 weeks, and is taught using a contemporary hybrid model that combines online and in-person learning into a world-class package.

The six core units, two of which focus on the completion of a major research project or thesis, are designed with the cutting edge of best practice. Students are invited to come onsite to our Ivanhoe campus, participate online, or mix and match to suit their schedules depending on the unit.

Tuition fees are payable upfront or through FEE HELP for eligible students. All fees are subject to annual CPI increases, and the fees shown in this guidebook reflect the tuition for 2024 and may not be accurate to years following. Year on year fee increases will be indicated on the ISN Psychology website.
